## MOBILE PHONE CONDUCT

Be prepared to lose your phone

**No using other people's phones**

- **If you have no phone, talk to a leader about using their phone**

**DO NOT** post any content on social media

You are responsible for your own phone **AT ALL TIMES**

- You may give it to a leader for security

**NO PHONES** in any bathrooms

**NO PHONE** usage in sleeping tents

**NO PHONE** usage during meal times

**30 minutes before dinner is phone time**

- **For Duty Patrol ... 30 minutes after dinner**
  - **Families encouraged NOT to contact Scouts**
  - **If home sick, talk to a leader before contacting family**
- NO entertainment usage**
