Adventure Title: Cradle Mountain Expedition

Describe your Adventure:

On the 2nd of April 2024 ten Venturers and three adults from the 1st Ballan Venturer Unit will embark on a ten-day journey of a lifetime across Bass Strait to Tasmania where we will spend a night or two in Davenport before beginning our journey on the Overland Track from Cradle Mountain to the Scout Hut. We will spend two nights at the Scout Hut with a day walk on the second day of the expedition exploring Cradle Mountain. After spending a second night at the Scout Hut we will continue our journey along the Overland track for 6 more days stopping along the track at Waterfall Valley, Windermere, Pelion, Kia Ora and Windy Ridge – Bert Nichols Hut and finishing at Lake St Clair. After the hike we will take a ferry to St Clair Lodge and then spend another night in Davenport before heading home to Victoria on the 12th of April 2024. Overall, we will be hiking 65 kilometres along the Overland Track from Cradle Mountain to Lake St Clair across 8 days and 7 nights. This adventure would provide those lucky thirteen people an experience of a lifetime as they trek along the Overland Track taking in the views of the natural Tasmanian landscape and spending time in vastly different environment to the ones they are used to. This expedition will be used as a King Scout Hike and means we will be carrying all our clothes, camping gear and cooking equipment, food and water throughout the duration of our hike. Not only does this amazing opportunity provide us with a King Scout Expedition it also allows the Venturers to expand their overnight hiking experience as beforehand we have only done two- or three-night expeditions. Our group is very active and doing this hike would take this to the next level by teaching us new skills and helping us learn how longer journeys are different to shorter journeys. We believe we are ready to take on this once in a lifetime experience and hope we can do so due to your generous funding.

- **Personal Progression**
This expedition will help us progress personally by giving us life experience and letting us learn how to plan, prepare and take part in a hike for over double the number of nights we have on previous hikes. It will also help progress the leader of the hike in the Venturer Scouting Journey by allowing them to complete their King Scout Journey.

- **Outdoor Adventure Skills (OAS)**
The Cradle Mountain Expedition would help all the youth taking part in the journey complete aspects of their core OAS work including:-
 - **Bushwalking Stage 6 & 7**
 - Taking part in a 3–4-night hike
 - The youth leaders of the hike will achieve extra parts in these stages by organising and running a hike for a 3–4-night duration.

- Bushcraft Stage 4 and 5
 - Advanced map reading skills
 - Improved ability to read and predict weather patterns
- Camping Stages 6 and 7
 - Camping under canvas for up to 32 nights
 - Leading the set-up of a camp.

How much financial support are you requesting from the fund?

We are requesting \$10,000 from the Dick & Pip Leadership Through Adventure fund.

While these are the main prices we have researched for this once in a lifetime trip we understand that there will be other expenses associated with the journey including but not limited to:-

- Prerequisite journeys to help youth learn, practice, experience and prepare for Cradle Mountain
- Food
- Group Equipment Costs

How will this financial support be used?

This financial support will be used to help pay for travel to Cradle Mountain via boat and to hire a bus so we can drive to and from Cradle Mountain. This money will also be used to pay for accommodation before, after & whilst on the Overland Track in Tasmania. We will also use these generous funds to purchase any supplies we might require while on the Overland Track such as food, first aid supplies and fuel for cooking.

What other source(s) of support will you access?

Some other sources of support we will be accessing are fundraising throughout the community to help fund this once in a lifetime trip. We will also be getting the people going on the trip to contribute money towards the total cost, but we hope that between the money we raise by fundraising and the money we receive from the Dick & Pip Smith Leadership Through Adventure Fund the cost families will have to pay to prepare and participate will be affordable.

How much are you planning to raise from these other sources?

We are planning on raising around \$4,000 from fundraising efforts and that will leave around \$1,000 to be split between 10 Venturers and 3 adults to complete the total costs of this amazing trip.

We will share the story of our once in a lifetime Cradle Mountain Expedition via:-
